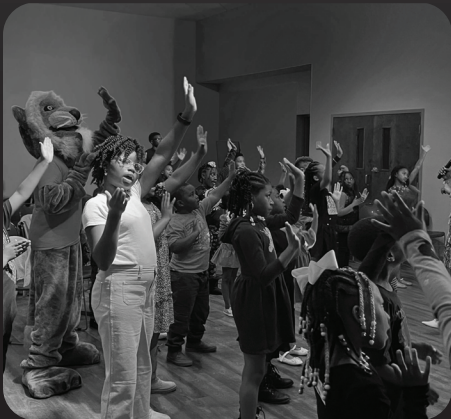

About the Role

West Point is looking for a Student Pastor who will partner with parents to disciple kids and students—from **babies who are walking all the way through college-aged adults**.

This role is about **building a unified next-gen ministry**, not running disconnected silos.

These numbers matter—but they're not the ceiling.

The ministry currently follows a large-group / small-group model and is supported by an enthusiastic volunteer base. There's openness—and excitement—around refining and strengthening the model under new leadership.

This is a role for someone who likes to build systems **and** sit on the floor with students.

Who This Role Is Ideally For

This role is not for someone looking to coast, copy-and-paste a playbook, or simply "keep the ministry going."

It *is* for a leader with a **hot, personal, and growing relationship with Jesus**—the kind that shows up in character, humility, accountability, and integrity when no one is watching. Spiritual maturity here isn't theoretical. It's visible, practiced, and trusted.

This role is for a builder.

Someone who doesn't just inherit systems, but improves them. Someone who takes ownership while remaining coachable—confident enough to lead, humble enough to listen, and wise enough to grow. You know how to carry responsibility *and* invite input without needing either to validate you.

You're a **self-starter** who doesn't wait to be told what to do—but you're not a lone ranger. You know how to galvanize volunteers, rally teams, and create momentum around a clear vision. People don't just follow you because of your title; they follow you because they trust you.

You think in **systems**, but you lead with **personality**.

You can design a pathway, manage a calendar, and build a volunteer pipeline—then turn around and sit across from a student and listen well. You have administrative chops, but they don't drain your soul. They serve the mission.

Most importantly, you see ministry growth through the **development of leaders**.

You don't measure success only by attendance, but by who is being formed, equipped, and released. You believe the win isn't doing everything yourself—it's building people who can carry the work forward with health and conviction.

If that sounds like how you're wired—and how you want to grow—this role will feel less like a job and more like a calling worth pursuing.
